Bayou City Road Runners was started in 1984 by a few employees of Getty Oil which later merged with Texaco. Bayou City began to flourish and increase its membership in the late 80's and early 90's, and now ranks as the largest running club in Houston. The club has parties after almost all of the HARRA championship races and whenever the mood strikes. Every Monday evening, we meet for an easy social run followed by dinner and drinks. In addition, we have a Wednesday workout (either a speed workout or a training run...take your pick) after which we reward ourselves with a visit to "Valhalla", a pub on the Rice University campus for beer, fun and dinner nearby afterwards. Every Sunday morning, we meet at Memorial Park for an 10 to 12 mile run and head for breakfast afterwards. Our club works several runs each year including the Jingle Bell Run in December. It's our way of giving back to the running community. And it's not just about running. We also have happy hours, bowling outings, volleyball nights, ski trips, international marathon trips, hiking trips etc. So, regardless of your ability or goals, membership in Bayou City is fun.

Bayou City has had great success in InterClub Competition sponsored by HARRA. What is the InterClub Competition? Each running club gains points for fielding teams at a series of races designated as HARRA races ranging from 5K to the Houston Marathon, and including two relay races. These are tallied up and at the end of the season a winner is announced. This HARRA competition fosters healthy competition and interaction between clubs and Bayou City more often than not comes out on top every year. Our team spirit and talent go along way in helping us achieve this. Within the club is a "Most Valuable Runner" competition based on a combination of participation and ability within six age groups. Awards for this and other feats during the year are given at our annual Award Banquet held in mid May.

Bayou City's colors are purple and white. Singlets, T-shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts, tyvek jackets, caps and golf shirts with the club logo are available for purchase. 'Word From The Bird' is the club newsletter.
